

What is a Makerspace?

- A physical facility with tools and resources that members of the public can utilize, typically via a monthly membership model.
- Individual members take short classes to learn how to use the tools and design resources, and then they may use them as if they were their own.

A community-oriented makerspace with the classic tools and high-tech equipment needed to bring big ideas to life.


Our members —from startup founders and small businesses to corporate teams and hobbyists are united by a passion for creativity, collaboration and camaraderie.


A NEW HUB OF CREATIVITY AND INNOVATION.
