

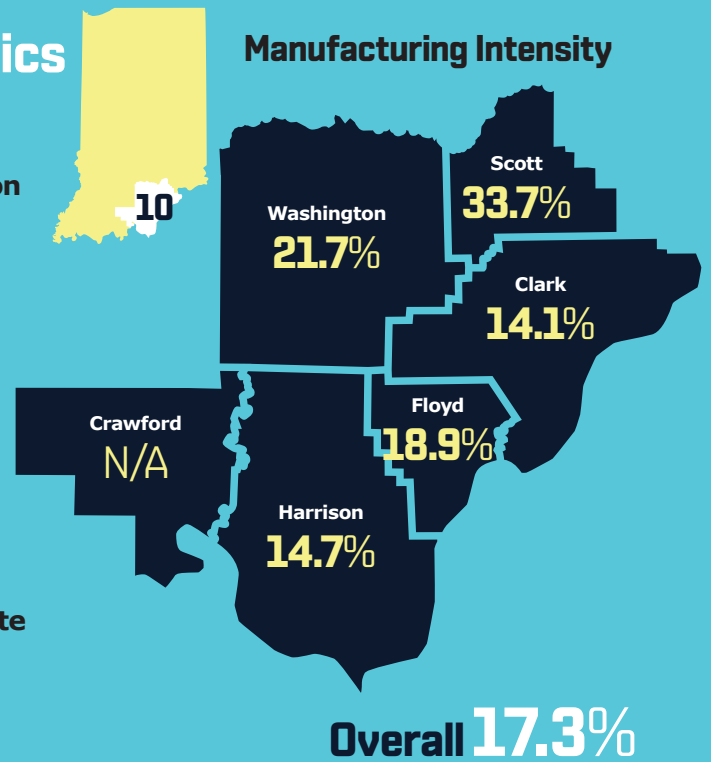

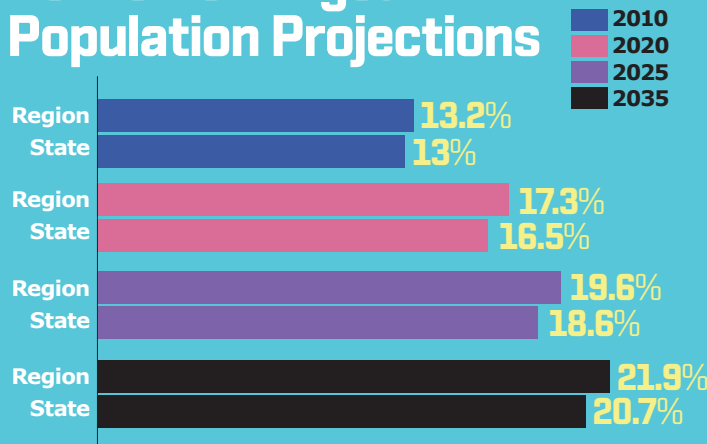

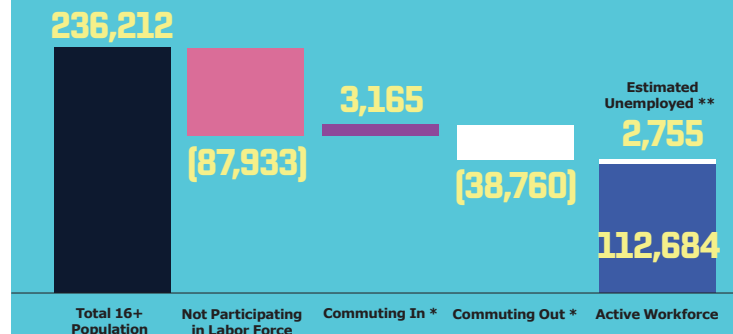
Workforce Region 10 is located near the IN-KY border and contains the Indiana portion of the Louisville/Jefferson County metropolitan area. This region's manufacturing intensity of 17.3 percent is in line with the overall state average of 17.4 percent. Its population of slightly over 300,000 residents represents 4.5 percent of the total state's population and has increased by 2.9 percent over the last 5 years (slightly higher than the state average). The average median age of 41 years is approximately

3 years higher than the state overall. As of March 2022, the region's labor participation rate of 63.3 percent is slightly above the state average of 62.4 percent. Commuting statistics indicate the region is impacted by a net outflow of workers to neighboring geographic areas, specifically to Kentucky. The overall available workforce seeking employment within Region 10 is 1.9 percent (2,755), which by most standards is considered full employment.
