PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Advanced Manufacturing and Logistics (AML) Ambassadors program creates and expands work-based learning opportunities for K-12 students through collaboration with industry leaders and education systems.

REGIONAL FOCUS

Ambassadors serve geographic areas based on manufacturing intensity, number of CTE concentrators, work-based learning coordinator coverage, career centers and workforce participation rate. The first phase of the ambassadors program is deployed across DWD Regions 2, 3, 6 and 9, covering Elkhart, LaGrange, Wayne, Henry, Bartholomew and Decatur counties.

LOCALIZED EFFORTS

By connecting with local AML companies and school corporations, AML ambassadors assist in the successful implementation of Graduation Pathways and Next Level Programs of Study (NLPS) and improve student outcomes, specifically as it relates to CTE programming and utilization of work-based learning as a graduation pathway.

Leveraging Conexus Indiana's unique position as a connector, AML ambassadors are establishing long-term relationships that industry and education partners rely on. Our ambassadors facilitate partnerships and help to ensure a spirit of collaboration, both locally and regionally, across industry partners and neighboring school systems.
